The initial meeting focuses on what your goals are and making a plan to achieve them.

Family Support Workers are available to assist with:

- Home-based, on-site case management for family assistance
- Developing and enhancing family relationships
- Enhancing social and life skills
- Family support around child behaviour
- Empowering families to achieve positive life outcomes
- Information and referral pathways to appropriate services including other KEYS programs such as: supported playgroups, counselling, parenting workshops and the Parents as Teachers program
- Families experiencing domestic violence/ homelessness and financial problems
- Transport assistance with prior arrangement

KEYS welcome Aboriginal families, families from other cultural backgrounds and grandparents raising their grandchildren.

The Family Support Worker is bound by an 'Oath of Confidentiality' in relation to family support sessions. However, where there is a threat or risk to an individual's safety, confidentiality may be waived.
