A one night workshop for couples

Couples are encouraged to participate in this course together, however if this is not possible, it is acceptable for one partner to participate on their own.



Step-families and blended families operate differently, their dynamics are complex and there is a need for special understanding and management for a healthy step-family to grow. This one night workshop helps you understand the differences inherent in being a step or blended family and equips you with skills to create a loving and successful family.

- Explore myths and expectations of the step-family
- Understand the life cycle stages of the step-family
- Explore themes of grief and loss for all members of the family
